<b>City Utility Services</b>	<b>Minimum Rate</b>	<b>Additional Charge</b>
<b>Gas</b>	\$9.00 – 1 <sup>st</sup> 1000 cubic feet	\$8.45 per 1000 cubic feet over minimum +/- fuel adjustment based on market rates
<b>Water</b>	\$8.00 – 1 <sup>st</sup> 3000 gallons	\$3.10 per 1000 gallons over minimum
<b>Water Fee</b>	\$0.032 per 1000 gallons	--
<b>Sewer*</b>	\$13.00	\$3.25 per 1000 gallons
<b>Trash / Recycle</b>	\$13.95	--

**Utility Bills**

- ... are mailed out the end of each month. Call City Hall if you have not received your bill by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month.
- ... are due the 12<sup>th</sup> of the month.
- ... not paid by the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month will result in your services being disconnected. To have your services reconnected, you will have to pay additional deposits, a reconnect fee and the full balance of the amount due.

**\*Sewer Rates**

- ... are calculated once a year by averaging the monthly water usage from November 15<sup>th</sup> through March 15<sup>th</sup>. The new sewer rate calculated by this average will show up on your May 1<sup>st</sup> bill.

**Trash & Recycle**

**Trash** pickup is every **Wednesday** and should be out at the **curb by 6:00** in the morning.

**Recycle** pickup is **every other Wednesday**.

If a major holiday falls on a Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday, trash and/or recycling pickup will move to Thursday. The major holidays are New Year's Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas. All other holidays will have normal scheduled pickup on Wednesday.

**Payment Options:** *We accept checks, cash, money orders & credit/debit cards. Please include the bill payment stub with your payment.*

- ... **Mail** – Make check payable to: **City of Hesston**  
 Mail payment to: **City of Hesston Utilities, PO Box 100, Hesston, KS 67062**
- ... **Drop-off** – You can drop off your payments **after hours** in the **drive-up tan box** located on the south side of the cul-de-sac just west of City Hall. Of course, during city business hours (**M-F, 8am-5pm**), you can drop off your payments at **City Hall, 115 E Smith**.
- ... **Automatic Bank Draft** – The draft can be taken out either the 2<sup>nd</sup> or the 11<sup>th</sup> of the month. If you are interested in the automatic bank draft, please contact City Hall or visit our website [www.hesstonks.org](http://www.hesstonks.org) for a form to sign up.
- ... **City of Hesston Online Bill Pay** – Follow the link on the City website [www.hesstonks.org](http://www.hesstonks.org) to sign up.
- ... **Hesston Resource Center** – 123 N Main, Hesston. Call 620.327.2729 for times open.
- ... NOTE: If you use **your bank's online bill pay system**, allow **7 days or more** for mailing time to ensure the check arrives prior to the due date. Even if the bank issues the check and takes it out of your account prior to the due date, if it does not arrive at the city office in time, you will be assessed a late penalty.

- Aluminum & steel (tin) beverage, food cans & aerosol cans
- Plastic beverage, food, & soap containers (#1 thru #7)
- Glass containers (all colors of food & beverage jars & bottles)
- Newspapers (including inserts), magazines, catalogs
- Food boxes, paper bags, junk mail, office paper, books, phone books
- Cardboard & pasteboard
